PART A - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MFRS 134

1. Basis of Preparation

These unaudited condensed consolidated interim financial statements (Condensed Report) of Yinson Holdings Berhad (the "Group") for the period ended 31 October 2013 have been prepared in accordance with *MFRS134: Interim Financial Reporting*, paragraph 9.22 and Appendix 9B of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. This condensed report also comply with *IAS34: Interim Financial Reporting* issued by the International Accounting Standards Board ("IASB").

This condensed report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 January 2013. The significant accounting policies and methods adopted for the unaudited condensed report are consistent with those adopted for the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 January 2013. The adoption of the following MFRSs and Amendments to MFRSs that came into effect on 1 February 2013 did not have any significant impact on the unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements upon their initial application.

2. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The Group's transport operations are generally affected by major festivals that occur in the first and third quarter of the financial year as there were fewer working days.

3. Unusual Items due to their Nature, Size or Incidence

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows during the current quarter and financial year to-date.

4. Changes in Accounting Estimate

There were no material changes in accounting estimates during the period under review that would have a material effect that would substantially affect the results of the Group.

5. Changes in the Composition of the Group

On 28 May 2013, the Company incorporated a wholly owned subsidiary, Yinson Production Limited, ("YPL") with a paid-up share capital of USD2,000.00. The principal activities of YPL shall be investment holdings and management services. YPL has not commenced its operations.

On 12 September 2013, the Company acquired 30% interests of Yinson Energy Sdn Bhd ("YESB") which is incorporated on same date. The authorised share capital of YESB is RM100,000.00 and the initial issued and paid-up capital is RM1,000.00. The intended principal activities of YESB are the provision of marine vessels for charter and marine services. YESB has not commenced its operations.

For management purposes, the Group is organized into business units based on their product and services, and has four operating segments as follows:

- (a) The marine segment consists of leasing of vessels, provision of barge services and marine management services.
- (b) The transport segment consists of the provision of trucking services.
- (c) The trading segment consists of trading activities mainly in the construction related materials.
- (d) Other operations consist of provision of warehouses, rental from investment properties and investment income.

Transactions between segments are carried out on mutually agreed basis. The effects of such inter-segment transactions are eliminated on consolidation.

Marine

Revenue from marine segment for the period under review has increased by RM16.465 million as compared to the corresponding prior period ended 31 October 2012. The increase was mainly due to the increase in contribution from chartering of two new vessels during the period under review. The increase in revenue resulted in an increase of the segment results for the period under review by RM1.480 million as compared to the corresponding prior period ended 31 October 2012.

Transport

Revenue from transport segment for the period under review has decreased by RM5.008 million or 5.9% as compared to the corresponding prior period ended 31 October 2012. The decrease was mainly due to the decrease in demand for the Group's transportation services. The decrease in revenue and drop in gross profit margin resulted in a decrease of the segment result by RM1.6 million as compared to the corresponding prior period ended 31 October 2012.

Trading

Revenue from trading segment for the period under review has decreased by RM11.617 million or 2.1% as compared to the corresponding prior period ended 31 October 2012. The decrease was mainly due to the decrease in demand and drop in average unit price of trading materials. The decrease in revenue, drop in gross profit margin and increase in provision for impairment of receivable have resulted in a decrease of the segment results by RM12.106 million as compared to the corresponding prior period ended 31 October 2012.

Other Operations

The segment profit of other operations increased to RM2.987 million as compared to loss of RM0.052 million in corresponding prior period ended 31 October 2012. The increase was mainly attributable to capital gain from sales of a non-recurrent item, increase in unrealised exchange gain and bad debt recovered.

Results of Joint Ventures and Associate

The share of the results of joint venture companies has increased to profit of RM25.457 million for the period ended 31 October 2013 as compared to loss of RM0.234 million for the corresponding prior period ended 31 October 2012 due to the revenue contribution from the commencement of floating storage and offloading vessel ("FSO") of a joint venture company.

Consolidated profit before tax

For the current period under review, the Group's profit before tax has increased by RM9.585 million or 25% to RM48.025 million as compared to RM38.440 million for the corresponding prior period ended 31 October 2012. The increase was mainly attributable to increase in contribution from marine segment, joint venture company and other operations and was partly offset by decrease in contribution from trading and transport segments, increase in net borrowing expenses of RM2.9 million and increase in share of loss in associate of RM2.1 million.

10. Acquisitions and disposals of property, plant and equipment

During the current period under review, the Group acquired property, plant and equipment with aggregate cost of RM9.573 million (31 October 2012: RM94.527 million).

Property, plant and equipment with a carrying amount of RM3.765 million were disposed by the Group during the current period ended 31 October 2013 (31 October 2012: RM0.610 million), resulting in a gain on disposal of RM0.558 million (31 October 2012: RM0.040 million) recognised and included in other operating income.

11. Fair Value Hierarchy

The Group uses the following hierarchy for determining the fair value of the financial instruments carried at fair value:

- Level 1 Quoted prices (unadjusted) in active markets for identical assets or liabilities
- Level 2 Inputs that are based on observable market data, either directly or indirectly
- Level 3 Inputs that are not based on observable market data

As at reporting date, the carrying amounts of available-for-sale investments and held for trading investment securities were measured by using Level 1 method in the hierarchy in determining their fair value.

12. Debt and Equity Securities

Except for the issuance of the 20,035,510 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each under private placements for RM2.82 for each share with total consideration of RM56.5 million, there were no other issuances, repayment of debts, share buy-backs, share cancellations, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares during the current period under review.

18. Event After The Reporting Date

(a) Acquisition of Fred. Olsen Production ASA ("FOP")

On 20 December 2013, YHB announced the settlement of the Offer Price to the FOP's shareholders who have accepted the Offer has been completed on 20 December 2013. Following the settlement, the Offer has now been completed and YHB owns 102,823,421 FOP Shares, equalling 97.1% of the outstanding FOP Shares and votes in FOP.

Upon the completion of the Offer, YHB intends to initiate a compulsory acquisition of the remaining FOP Shares not owned by YHB in accordance with applicable laws, and to propose that FOP applies for a delisting of FOP Shares from the Oslo Stock Exchange. It is expected that a compulsory acquisition of the remaining FOP Shares will be effected mid-January 2014.

(b) Share Issuance

On 4 December 2013, the Company announced the issuance of 37,809,000 new ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in YHB to a third party investor at an issue price of RM2.82 per share. The share issuance has been completed on 5 December 2013 with the listing of 37,809,000 new shares.

20. Material Changes in the Profit Before Taxation of Current Quarter Compared with Preceding Quarter

The Group's profit before tax for the 3rd quarter of FY 2014 has increased by RM3.647 million to RM16.851 million as compared to the RM13.204 million for preceding quarter. The increase was mainly due to gain on foreign exchange of RM3.7 million, capital gain from sales of non-recurring item and increase in contribution from joint venture business and offset by increase in provision for impairment of receivable.

21. Commentary on Prospects

The global economy expanded at a modest pace during the 9 months of 2013. Going forward, emerging signs of a recovery in the major advanced economies are expected to provide some support to overall global growth which will support growth in the Malaysian economy.

Barring unforeseen circumstances, the Group shall strive to sustain a satisfactory performance for the rest of the current financial year.

Interest rate swaps

The Group has entered into the following interest rate swap contracts to mitigate the Group's exposure from fluctuations in interest rate arising from a floating rate term loans:-

- i. contract amounting to RM56.133 million that receives floating interest at SIBOR + 2.75% p.a. and pays fixed interest at 3.40% p.a. and
- ii. contract amounting to RM24.856 million that receives a fixed rate of 2.5% p.a. + COF and pays a fixed rate of 2.5% p.a. + COF + fixed rate of 1.4% p.a. less one month LIBOR rate.

The interest rate swaps have similar maturity terms as the term loans.

The interest rate swaps have been classified as At Fair Value Through Profit or Loss which is measured at fair value and the changes in fair value will be taken to profit or loss.

Forward foreign currency exchange contracts

The Group has entered into a few forward foreign currency exchange contracts to mitigate the Group's potential exposure from fluctuations in foreign exchange rate of NOK against USD arising from a firm commitment in acquiring all ordinary shares of FOP as disclosed in Note 18. The forward foreign currency exchange contracts have maturities range from six to twelve months.

The forward foreign currency exchange contracts are measured at fair value and the gains or losses arising from the change in fair value of these contracts will be taken to profit or loss.

b) Gains/Losses Arising From Fair Value Changes in Derivatives

The net fair value loss on interest rate swap derivative measured at fair value through profit and loss for current period is RM0.129 million.

As at reporting date, the Group had applied fair value hedge accounting. The loss on change in fair value of the forward foreign currency exchange contracts amounting to RM7.865 million recognised to the profit or loss has been offset by the gain on fair value change in the firm commitment.

The fair values of the above derivatives were based on quotes obtained from the respective counterparty banks.
